Review of Systems:

General: weight loss, fatigue, weakness, fever, chills, change in appetite

Skin: rash, bruising, pruritus

HEENT: change in vision, change in hearing, glasses, tinnitus, change in smell/taste, gum bleeding, oral problems

Neck: problems swallowing

Chest: SOB, hemoptysis, cough, sputum, history of pneumonia

Heart: chest pain, murmur, palpitations, orthopnea, dyspnea on exertion

Abdomen: pain, change in bowel habits, nausea, vomiting, hematemesis, hemorrhoids, jaundice, hematochezia, fatty food intolerance

GU: hematuria, pain, frequency, urgency, polyuria, nocturia, incontinence, discharge

Gyn: Gravida / para, abortions, LMP, menarche, menopause, dysmenorrhea

Extremities: Weakness, edema, claudication

Neuro / Psych: loss of sensation, memory problems, syncope, seizures, sleep disorders, depression, headache, weakness
