

Selection of privately funded international students

(Excerpt version)

1. Number of selected students

A few students.

2. Qualifications for applicants

Those who do not have Japanese nationality, those who have taken the "Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students" conducted by the Japan Student Services Organization, those who have a status of residence that does not interfere with university life under the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, and those who fall under any of the following ① to ④ may apply for admission.

(Note) Precautions for taking the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students

- Please take the 2025 Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (2nd), which will be held in November 2025.
- Please select Japanese as the test language.
- Please take the three subjects of Japanese, science and mathematics.
- For science, please select 2 subjects from 3 subjects (physics, chemistry, biology).
- For mathematics, please select course 2.

- ① Those who have completed a 12-year course in school education in a foreign country, and those who are expected to complete one by March 31, 2026, or those who are equivalent to these and designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- ② Those who have acquired the International Baccalaureate Diploma awarded by the International Baccalaureate Secretariat, which is a foundation based on the Swiss Civil Code.
- ③ Those who have obtained the Abitur qualification recognized as a university entrance qualification in each state of the Federal Republic of Germany.
- ④ Those who have acquired the Baccalaureate Diploma recognized as a university entrance qualification in the Republic of France.

3. Selection methods

Selection will be made on the basis of an overall consideration of the results of individual academic ability tests, interviews, application documents, and the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students.

Therefore, even if the total score of the individual academic ability tests etc. exceeds the minimum score of successful applicants, it may not qualify for selection.

In addition, the University Admission Common Test is not imposed.

○ Subjects for individual academic ability tests.

Category	Subjects
Mathematics	Mathematics I, Mathematics II, Mathematics III, Mathematics A, Mathematics B, Mathematics C
Science	Select 2 subjects from "Basics of physics / Physics", "Basics of biology / Biology", and "Basics of chemistry / Chemistry"
Foreign language	"English" ("English Communication I", "English Communication II", "English Communication III", "Logic and Expression I", "Logic and Expression II", "Logic and Expression III")

(Note 1) Regarding the test range in mathematics, Mathematics I, Mathematics II, Mathematics III, and Mathematics A will be given from the entire range. Mathematics B is set from "sequences" and "statistical inference", Mathematics C is set from "vectors" and "curves on a plane and complex plane".

(Note 2) For Science, the subjects listed in quotation marks will be one subject. The test range is as follows:

- "Basics of physics / Physics" will be given from the entire range of Basics of physics and Physics.
- "Basics of biology / Biology" will be given from the entire range of Basics of biology and Biology.
- "Basics of chemistry / Chemistry" will be given from the entire range of Basics of chemistry and Chemistry.

(Note 3) Listening tests will not be conducted for Foreign language subjects.

4. Application period

From Monday, January 26, 2026 to Wednesday, February 4th, 2026.

5. Dates of selection tests (dates of individual academic ability tests, etc.)

Wednesday, February 25, 2026: Individual academic ability tests.

Thursday, February 26, 2026: Interview.

6. Announcement for successful applicants

Saturday, March 7, 2026.

7. Period for admission procedures

From Saturday, March 7th, 2026 to Sunday, March 15th, 2026 (excluding Sunday, March 8th, 2026 and Saturday, March 14, 2026).

8. Others

- ① Education after enrollment is the same as those who enrolled by general selection.
- ② In principle, classes are conducted in Japanese.
- ③ For application qualifications, please contact the Admissions Section of the Education and Training Support Division of this University and confirm your eligibility before applying.
