



Within a year, 10% decline in under 5-yo pop.

Characteristics

- Age, residency
- Pregnancy and medical histories

Perinatal items

- Antenatal and delivery care
- Complications

Child health items

- Gestational week, anthropometries
- Child abnormalities

Parenting items

- Maternal depression
- Feeding method
- Concerns (Open-ended question)

Telephone counseling for mothers with depressive symptoms and parenting concerns




